REPORT OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY PRSENTED TO THE 2023 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF ST. JOHN'S OLD BOYS' ASSOCIATION, HELD ON SATURDAY,

JANUARY 20, 2024 ON ZOOM.

Responsibility stems from being in charge of the Secretariat of this noble Association which has proven to be a foremost stakeholder in the education sector of Osun State and pride coming from the realization of SJOBA being the flagship for all other Old Student Association in the entire Southwest geo political zone of Nigeria as severally confirmed by the Osun State Ministry of Education. I feel a high sense of honour and privilege to be of service at this auspicious time. Thank you All for the great opportunity.

The Year 2023 started with a lot of apprehension about the dwindling economic fortunes of Nigeria and the forthcoming February Presidential elections which the naysayers and most Spiritual Fathers predicted will be bloody, inconclusive and anarchical. The truth we witnessed was a peaceful election and all the usual political, legal and quasi legal intrigues which heralded in the administration of President Bola Ahmed Tinubu and a tumultuous set of reforms that saw Year on Year inflation soaring through the roof and over 500% devaluation of the Naira. There are over 2500 Members resident in Ile-Ife and Three of our Members are Chairmen of the Local Council Development Areas created by the Osun Sate

Government. It is expected that the mother chapter will be the front runner of all activities in Ile-Ife.

The 1999/2000 Sets have formed a formidable Association and are working with the National Secretariat to register a formidable presence in SJOBA. Ably led by Oladimeji Ebenezer and Eze Sunday as Coordinator and Asst. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Consequently, students who couldn't cope with the rigorous academic exercise withdrew leaving only about 360 Students who raised our hope that the days of 100% performance in external examinations. Today, St. John's Grammar School has become the school of choice for discerning Parents in Ile-Ife. Now, we can beat our chests that our Alma Mater is the only school where Science Practical will be taught in the entire Osun East Education District.

Chief Jibola Awoseyi annual Debate and Table Tennis Competitions was held with funfair and a new Set of Confident Students were revealed. They participated in the Odunayo Olagbaju Memorial Quiz Competition where they came Third position in the entire 3 Local Governments in Ile-Ife.

Captain Mukaila Adeniyi Ademiju sponsored the renaissance of the Boys Scout and the Red Cross Society in our Alma Mater. He sponsored complete Kits for 40 Students and 4 Teacher Coordinators. These earned us another Golden Feather in the Osun State Ministry of Education where a directive was issued instantly that all schools in the State should sponsor at least 5 students each as members of the Boys Scout Association and Red Cross Society. We pray that more members will come forward to sponsor Clubs and Associations in reminiscence of our school days where intensive academic rivalry are stimulated by participation in clubs and societies. It is on record that our Alma Mater is the only School in Osun State that held her Inter House sports competition in 2023. We commend all Members who supported the School Management and plead for more involvement of SJOBA in future.

We hereby express gratitude to all Members who paid their annual dues in 2023. Equally, we give kudos to all the Set Coordinators who drove the payment of annual dues and project levy at Set levels.  - b. Chemistry
 - c. Biology
 - d. Agricultural Science
 - e. Yoruba
 - f. Government

This will complement the 21 Teaching Staff provided by the Government

- 7. To reward education stakeholders and students whose sterling performances made our remarkable efforts pronounced by the Osun State Government.
- 8. To procure all materials including Data, Annual registration, Airtime and Hardware and employ an Administrator, necessary for the smooth running of the SJOBA NATIONAL SECRETARIAT.
