The meeting commenced at 11.40 a.m. with an opening prayer by Ambassador Obisakin. After the adoption of the Agenda, the National President, Engr. Adewuyi Adetogun read his address to the participants at the meeting.

HIGHLIGHTS / OBSERVATIONS AT THE MEETING

The following are some of the observations and highlights of the meeting:

1. The External Auditor's efforts to present virtually were thwarted due to technical glitches. The report had to be presented by the Internal Auditor of SJOBA.
2. VP 4 reiterated his plea to have a reliable data base of Johnian members in the diaspora. Their contacts should be available so that they can reach out to members irrespective of wherever they are. He also announced that on the 6th of October 2026 a reunion of SJOBA will be held in London (More information would be made available in the coming days). In addition, he mooted the idea of

registering SJOBA as a charity organization which would make it possible to operate as a corporate entity and not as separate units. He also appealed to Set Coordinators to forward the contacts of their mates resident abroad to the Secretariat. Johnian Sam Oludunfe also supported this idea.

3. Ambassador Obisakin pledged an award for the best students in Bible Knowledge, Biology and French (if the subject was still being offered).
4. Ambassador Obisakin observed that there should be a maintenance committee to take care of infrastructure and upkeep of the environment. In his reaction, Johnian Awoyemi noted that this idea is outside the purview of SJOBA as the Association is for intervention. In his opinion, BoG should oversee such a Committee. Johnian Yomi Layinka concurred with this observation by stating that the BoG is a representative of the State Government. He however promised that the Board will be more proactive in 2026 as far-reaching transformation programmes will be embarked upon.
5. Opening of new chapters and tackling of academic decadence to be embarked upon vigorously this year.

COMMISSIONING OF PROJECTS

Three projects were commissioned at the Annual General Meeting Saturday 27 December 2025.

1. The first project was the donation of 50 sets of graduate chairs and lockers by the 71/75 set.

This was to mark their 50th anniversary of leaving the school. The presentation was done by the BoG Chairman who also doubles as the Set Coordinator, Johnian Yomi Layinka. He was ably assisted by SJOBA immediate past president, Dr. Festus Oshoba. The immediate past principal of the school (Mrs. Modupe Adisa) was given the honourable task of cutting the tape.

2. The second commissioning done was that of the already installed inverter by the 77/82 Set. The capacity of the high-grade solar power grid is immense such that it will:

- i. relieve the school of the perennial power outages, and
 - ii. power water pumping machine and other electrical installations i.e. ACs, Fridges, fans, etc
3. The National President commissioned the five white boards and other accessories donated by the 2005 Set.
